### FEBRUARY 11: WORLD DAY OF THE SICK

In 1993, Pope John Paul II declared the Memorial of Our Lady of Lourdes (February 11) to be “World Day of the Sick”. In doing so, he addressed himself particularly to those who suffer:

“To you, dear sick people all over the world, the main actors of this World Day, may this event bring the announcement of the living and comforting presence of the Lord. Your sufferings, accepted and borne with unshakeable faith, when joined to those of Christ take on extraordinary value for the life of the Church and the good of humanity.”

He also said, “Illness and pain affect every human being: love for the suffering is the sign and measure of the degree of civilization and progress of a people.”

Let us pray with confidence for all the sick of our families, our parish, and the world. As they bear the cross of their infirmity, may they bear much fruit for themselves and others. And may our love for them be a light to those in the darkness of despair.

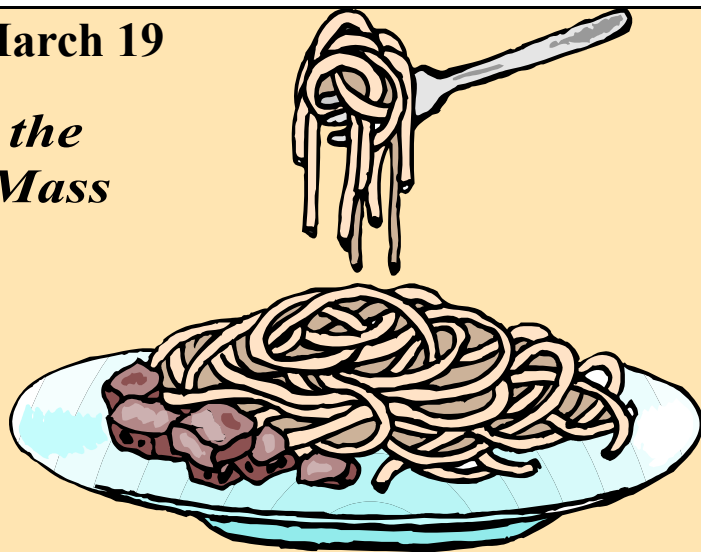
