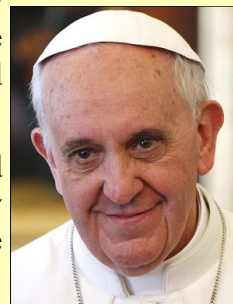

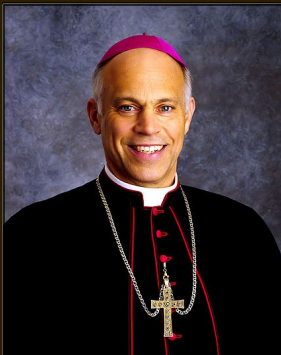


PARISH BBQ PICNIC WITH ARCHBISHOP CORDILEONE

Speaker: John Black, Principal of St. Rita School

Topic: *Educating Future Leaders for the International Community*

John was born in Massachusetts and graduated from **Bethany College** in Kansas with a BS in math and economics. After serving in the **Peace Corps** in Africa, he earned a Master's degree in Education from the **Univ. of New Orleans**. He taught for nine years in Africa, Central America, and the United States, then began an administrative career as a principal in Manteca, CA in 1999, serving for four years.

He relocated to the East Coast in 2003 and served for five years as the principal of **St Francis International School** outside of Washington DC. In 2008, then accepted a three-year contract in Dubai at an international school serving mostly Arab students from the Gulf countries. Prior to returning to California to be the principal of **St. Rita School**, he accepted a two year contract at an international school in the Philippines. There he became familiar with **the International Baccalaureate Program** which is now being implemented at St. Rita School. The program was first established in Geneva Switzerland in the late 1960s and has become increasingly popular in the United States over the past twenty years for its academic rigor and international-mindedness. St. Rita will also be implementing a middle school **STEM** program, emphasizing a project-based approach to teaching and learning that prepares students for accelerated math and science classes in high school.

He is married with five children, three of whom attend St. Rita School.

Sept. 30: St. Jerome, priest & doctor of the Church. He died in 420. He translated the books of the Bible into Latin (the "Vulgate"), and wrote many commentaries. He said, "Ignorance of Scripture is ignorance of Christ!"

Oct. 1: St. Thérèse of Lisieux died in 1897 at the age of 24. She was a Carmelite nun. Her simple autobiography Story of a Soul made her a "Doctor of the Church".
