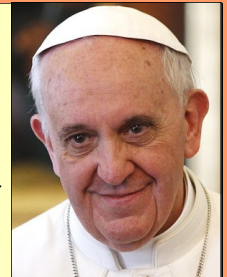

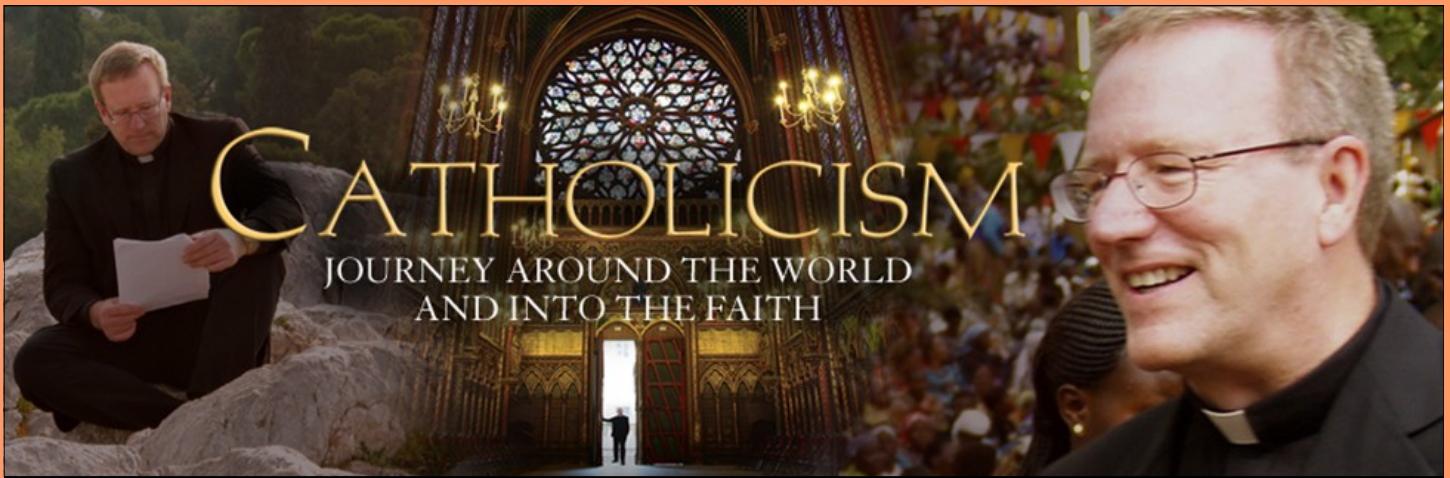

CATHOLICISM VIRTUAL PILGRIMAGE COURSE STARTING THURSDAY OCTOBER 6!

Deacon Dave will be leading an adult study of Catholicism for 6 Thursdays, in the hall, 7-8PM, beginning on Oct. 6. The course will meet weekly for 6 weeks, ending on Nov. 10.
