**Fr. Bill Thornton**



Father Bill has been our pastor since July 1st. He is from a Navy family, which frequently moved. During his childhood, he lived in various parts of the country although he has been in California for most of his life.

Fr. Bill is a late vocation, having been ordained in 2009. He graduated from St Patrick's Seminary in that year. He has had various assignments in the Archdiocese. He has previously served in Marin County, at St. Anthony's Parish in Novato, for five years. His last assignment was as the Catholic priest at the San Mateo Medical Center and the Burlingame Long Term Care Center. Fr. Bill has a special interest in ministry in hospitals and care centers.

Prior to entering the seminary, Fr. Bill was a bank staff attorney. He started at Security Pacific National Bank, which was later merged into Bank of America. He graduated from the University of Pennsylvania in 1968 and from the University of Pennsylvania Law School in 1974. From 1968 to 1971, he was on active duty in the Navy.
