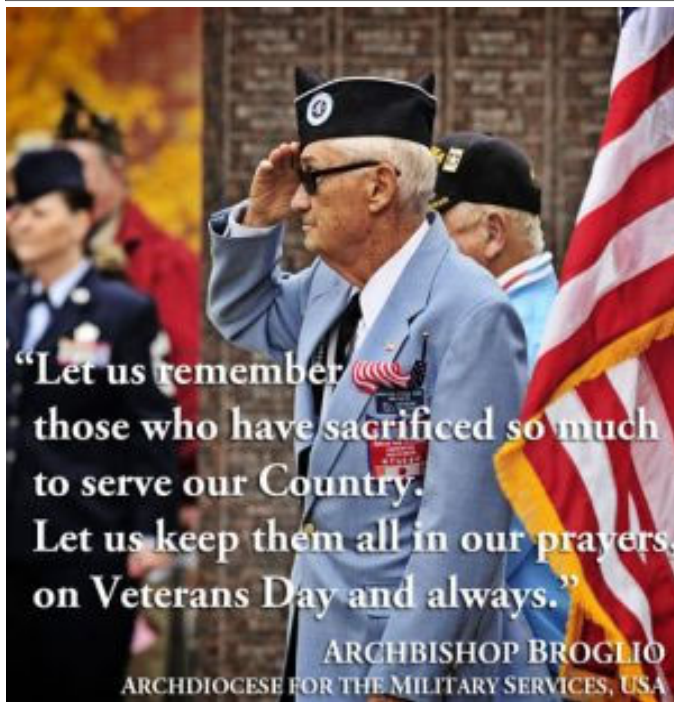

Pastor's Statement on Return to Indoor Masses and Need for Cleaning Volunteers

Outdoor Masses accommodate more people and are obviously safer, during a pandemic, than indoor Masses. For these reasons, I have been delaying the return to indoors as long as possible. Many of you have supported me for this reality-based decision and I appreciate it.

Because weather conditions will eventually force us indoors, we have been preparing for this for several weeks. However, one significant problem remains. Both the County and the Archdiocese itself have imposed very strict cleaning requirements on churches. The Archdiocesan directive also adds the following: "Each parish is to identify an established volunteer core to assist in the sanitizing of the church after each Mass." Previously, we sent out a request for cleaning volunteers on Flocknote but only two came forward. Now we are asking again. We need a reliable, committed cleaning squad **for each Mass**. It would be fitting for anyone who has been pushing for a hasty return indoors to be in the forefront of these cleaning volunteers.
